# **Housing Policy, Eligibility & Points**

# Who Is Eligible for Housing Reassignment?

All single MD, PhD, MD-PhD WCM Students currently living in WCM housing are *guaranteed* housing

All PA and Linkage students are *eligible* for housing and housing is based on available inventory

Family housing is not guaranteed and based on available inventory

All 7<sup>th</sup> Year MD-PhDs live in Rockefeller University housing

# Housing Term

- Housing is done on an academic year basis (July 1 – June 30)
- MD and PA students who are graduating in 2026 must move out by May 17, 2026
- PhD students must move out 60 days after dissertation defense

## Families with Children

- One-bedrooms are reserved for families with children
- Family one-bedrooms are not part of this application process

## Families of Two (Couples)

- Couples live in studios at Feil / Weill or Ladson House
- Students can apply through this application process for a **Feil / Weill** studio and then contact the Housing Office to add their partner as a secondary occupant
- You may remain on the family waitlist during the application process for Ladson studios
- WCM Housing requires a marriage certificate or domestic partnership certificate to qualify for family housing
- Couples are not allowed to live in two-shares (two people in one bedroom and a third person in the second bedroom)

Once the Office of Civil Rights approves an accommodation, WCM Housing works to provide appropriate housing. Housing is based on availability.

# Housing Reassignment Points System for On-Campus Students

MD, PhD or MD-PhD, 3<sup>rd</sup> year  
**4 points**

MD, PhD or MD-PhD, 1<sup>st</sup> year  
**2 points**

MD, PhD or MD-PhD, 2<sup>nd</sup> year  
**3 points**

Off-campus, PA, and Linkage students  
**1 point**

# Housing Reassignment Points System



- Students and roommate groups are assigned point values
- Mixed year groups average their points
- Housing accommodations are considered as part of point allocations
- Those with the same points are randomized
- Housing selection timeslots are assigned in descending point order
- Points for students living in WCM and MSK housing are calculated the same way; no penalty for living in MSK housing
- The maximum number of points a person may have is four, regardless of how many years of study

# Important Notes About Moving Off-Campus

- If you move off-campus, housing is no longer guaranteed, and it can be very hard to secure on-campus housing in the future
- Rising second years not living in WCM Housing for summer recess are **not** considered to be off-campus and can return before August class start without impacting points
- After the start of the second year, any move out of WCM Housing is considered an off-campus move
- You must *fully vacate* Olin Hall by June 14 if you are not living in WCM housing the summer after your first year. You may return to campus August 22 when classes resume

All students must move out of Olin Hall


- Summer 2026 students move in May 30

# Reassignment Process Overview

Step 1—Decide if you want to stay in your current room, invite a WCM classmate to move into your two- or three-share, or participate in room reassignment

Step 2—Complete housing application and, if applicable, create roommate group


Step 3—View anticipated vacancies

Step 4—Log into housing portal at appointed time and select housing

Step 5—Move-in dates are assigned  
Moves start in May and *continue throughout the summer*

# New Renewal Policy This Year


- Students living in Olin cannot remain in Olin Hall; all other students may remain in the same room
- To stay in your current room, **YOU MUST RENEW YOUR HOUSING AGREEMENT** in the [WCM Housing Portal](#).  
**This is a new policy for the 2026 – 2027 academic year.**
- If you do not renew your housing agreement, your room will be visible as vacant during room selection and another student may select it for the next year.

# Step 2—Roommate Groups

## FERPA WAIVER – Education Information (Housing)

# Step 2—Roommate Groups

## Group Leader Role

The Group Leader must be the **Invitor** — the student who currently lives in the apartment and has a bedroom available. The Group Leader is responsible for assigning bedrooms to all members of the group.

If you are the Invitor and you are not currently the Group Leader, the process will not work correctly. Only the current Group Leader can transfer the role to another group member. If this applies to you, ask your Group Leader to reassign the role to you before proceeding.

SAVE & CONTINUE

- You may create a roommate group, which allows a group to select rooms together
- Each person in a group will be assigned the same timeslot
- Only the Group Leader can assign bedrooms. In the case of *Invite a Friend*, only the invitor can be the Group Leader

## Step 3—View Expected Vacancies Starting March 19

Expected vacancies are rooms that are:

1. Currently vacant
2. Currently house a student graduating in 2026
3. Currently house a student who did not sign a room renewal
  - *If you opted into housing reassignment your room will be a choice for another student next year*
  - *This is why it is key that you renew your room if you do not want to move*

## Step 3—View Expected Vacancies

- Prior to room selection:
  - You can see expected vacancies
  - If you do not like the options available, you can withdraw from housing selection and remain in your room.

**The deadline to Return to Room is March 27**
- Roommate groups can be altered throughout housing selection process

# Step 4—Room Selection

## Timeslots

- Each person or roommate group is assigned a timeslot for when they can *begin* to login and select an apartment
- Timeslots are assigned on a points basis, highest points go first
- In the case of equal points, groups/individuals will be allocated times in a random order

## Room Selection

- The WCM Housing Portal allows you to pick your specific apartment
- You may pick your apartment anytime between your assigned start time and the close of housing selection

### Initial Selection

Once you have made your selection, please scroll down and click "Save and Continue."

Each bedroom is listed individually below. For example, Room SR-1007A and Room SR-1007B are different bedrooms in apartment SR-1007. If you are a group leader you must add both bedrooms to your cart. After both bedrooms are selected, scroll down and click *Save & Continue*

- At or after your appointed time, log into the WCM Housing Portal and select your room
- You will be able to see vacancies right up until your timeslot

# Step 4—Room Selection, Shares

## Splitting up roommate groups or altering configurations

- If the housing type your group wants is not available, you will have to select a room with another student, split up the group, or alter the configuration
- If Sally and Lucy want to live in a two-share and none are available, they can:
  - Select two bedrooms in a three-share where the third bedroom is already occupied
  - Dissolve the group and then Sally and Lucy each pick their own empty shares in separate apartments
  - If a three-share is available, add a third roommate to their group
- It is strongly recommended that roommate groups discuss in advance alternatives to their first choice

## Step 5—Moving

- After housing selection, you will receive a confirmation of your booking and be able to see it on the WCM Housing Portal
- Move dates are assigned by WCM Housing staff; during housing selection you will rank move weeks by order of preference
- Move dates are assigned by housing staff because there is not a singular move out day
- Moves will begin in May *and continue throughout the summer*
- Time is needed between moves for Housing Operations to clean and update rooms
- **No movers are provided for any WCM Buildings.** If you wish to hire private movers please contact WCM Housing first to ensure proper insurance and paperwork
