

Feil Family and Weill Family Residence Hall
Huddle Room Policies and Procedures

1. The Huddle rooms, located in the Feil Family and Weill Family Residence Hall, are free and available for use by WCM residents.
2. Huddle rooms are available to currently enrolled students with a valid ID.
3. Use is limited to individuals or small groups consisting of 2-6 people.
4. Huddle rooms are intended for group study or collaboration, virtual meetings or interviews, project work, or academic discussions.
5. Huddle rooms are not intended for social gatherings, napping, or sleeping, or to be used as a private office.
6. Spaces available for reservation include Huddle room SR124 and SR125.
7. Reservations can be made via the StarRez system.
8. Repeated no-shows or overstaying may result in suspended privileges.
9. Please keep noise to a minimum, use headphones for audio or virtual meetings.
10. Please refrain from sleeping, lying on the floor, or bringing in large furniture.
11. No food is allowed. Drinks are permissible only in a spill-proof container.
12. Please leave the room clean and dispose of any trash.
13. Please do not leave personal belongings unattended.
14. All WCM-sponsored programs must be open to all residents of WCM and advertised no fewer than 48 hours in advance.
15. Members of the WCM Staff have priority to reserve spaces for activities. No organization outside of WCM may reserve a room earlier than 2 weeks before the event.
16. The Rooftop Lounge cannot be reserved under any circumstances. It is kept available for Feil family and Weil family residence hall events, as planned by WCM.
