

WCM Housing Eligibility

- SINGLE students currently living on-campus are *guaranteed* housing
- Family housing it is not guaranteed and is based on available inventory
- Family housing is 77th Street, Lasdon studios, and Feil Weill. Twoperson families may live in the Feil Weill Residence studios
- 7th Year MD-PhDs may only live in Rockefeller
- Physicians Assistant & Linkage students are eligible for housing, but are not guaranteed housing and housing is based on available inventory

Family Housing

Families with Children


- One-bedrooms are reserved for families with children
- Family one-bedrooms are not part of this application process
- Contact the Housing Office to be placed on the family housing waitlist

Families of Two (Couples)

- Couples may live in the studios
- Students should apply through this application process for a studio and then contact the Housing Office to add their partner as a secondary occupant
- You may remain on the family waitlist during the application process
- WCM Housing requires a marriage certificate or domestic partnership certificate to qualify for family housing
- Couples are not allowed to live in two-shares



Typical Floorplan: Studios










Each student will create their own profile for the Feil Family & Weill Family Residence Hall. This is the first part of the housing application process

Your profile will allow you to:

- Confirm your information is correct
- Select general roommate preferences, including sharing your contact information
- Link your application to a preferred roommate


Non-WCM Housing Residents (MSK, RU, off-campus)

- 1. You need to register to create an account
- 2. Click Register
- 3. Follow prompts to create account

You can log in or create your account now. While you must wait until June 30 to create your Feil Family and Weill Family Student Residence housing profile, early login allows us more time to address any potential login issues.


Due to federal privacy laws, WCM Housing cannot disclose your housing information to any party



Both roommates must have created a profile AND consent to sharing contact information

After both roommates have created a profile and consented to sharing information, click "Search for Roommates by Details"


Your preferred roommate will receive an email notifying them of your request. Your roommate must log in and accept the invitation.

Both parties must agree to be in a housing group to be roommates

When your roommate logs in, they will see an option to accept or decline your roommate request.


They *must accept* the request to link your applications.

Step 2: Housing Selection, Overview

- The WCM Housing Portal allows you to pick your specific apartment
- Each person or roommate group is assigned a timeslot for when they can *begin* to login and select an apartment.
- Timeslots are assigned on a points basis, highest points go first
- There will be daily time slots every 30 minutes
- You may pick your apartment anytime between your assigned start time and July 20th, 11:59PM
- In the case of equal points, groups/individuals will be allocated times in a random order



Step 2: Housing Selection, Points Calculation

How are points determined?

Year	Points
Rising 4 th year or above	4 points
Rising 3 rd year	3 points
Rising 2 nd year	2 points
Off-Campus and other categories	1 point

<u>Notes</u>

- Points for all students living in WCM, MSK, and Rockefeller housing are calculated the same way;
 there are no deductions for living in MSK or Rockefeller housing
- The maximum number of points a person may have is four, regardless of how many years of study
- If you enter the housing system as a roommate grouping your points are averaged together, i.e., a roommate paring of a second year and third year student would have 2.5 points



Accommodations Office of Institutional Equity

Accommodations

- WCM Office of Institutional Equity must have approved your request for an accommodation
- If your accommodation is *specifically* for the Feil Family & Weill Family Residence Hall, you will be placed first on the selection list
- If your accommodation is not for the new residence hall, 0.5 points are added to your point calculation





At your appointed time, log into the WCM Housing Portal and begin selection



Step 2: Housing Selection, Apartment Selection



Select your room and add it to your cart.

Then scroll to the bottom of the page to continue.

Key Items:

General

- Each box is a *bedroom*. If you are selecting two-share, each bedroom is labeled A and B. i.e. SR1007A, is the Student Residence 10th floor, Apartment 07, Bedroom A
- Floorplans on the Housing website are labeled Bedroom A and B
- Studios are all Bedroom A

Linked Applications

- Group leaders pick bedrooms for *both* parties. This eliminates the need for both roommates to be in the system simultaneously.
- The group leader should select both bedrooms to add to cart





Each bedroom is listed individually below. For example, Room SR-1007A and Room SR-1007B are different bedrooms in apartment SR-1007. If you are a group leader you must add both bedrooms to your cart. After both bedrooms are selected, scroll down and click Save & Continue


As Group Leader, Lucy is picking SR-1007 for both Lucy and Sally.

After adding bedrooms A and B to her cart, she scrolls to the bottom of the page to continue.

If you are selecting a two-share without a preferred roommate, you will only be allowed to select one bedroom




Step 2: Housing Selection, Bedroom Selection



On the next page, Group Leader Sally assigns the specific bedroom to each person




Step 2: Housing Selection, Move In Date



- After confirming your room choices, you can select your move in date and time.
- Move in days are August 1, 2, 3, 18 and 19.
- If you cannot move in any of these days, <u>pick the</u> <u>date closest to when you can move in</u>. The system will not let you move forward without picking a date. Then contact the Housing Office and we will work with you to find a date that works.
- If you a Group Leader, you are only picking a move in date for yourself; your roommate will login and pick their own separate date




Step 2: Housing Selection, License Signing



- A Housing License Agreement is generated based on your move-in date
- You must DOWNLOAD the license for your files
- You must electronically sign the document. Your signature name must match your name exactly as it is in the system.



Step 2: Housing Selection, Confirmation



Lucy's Housing Selection is Complete!!


Apartment 1007 is assigned to Lucy and Sally.

As the group leader, only Sally has completed the process since only she has signed her License Agreement.

Lucy must now log in and select a move in date, which can be different from Sally's, and sign her License Agreement.



Step 2: Housing Selection, Roommate License Signing




When Lucy logs in, she will see her room assignment on the homepage.

She then selects the Feil & Weill Residence Hall application process and picks her own move in date. It can be different than Sally's move in date.

Lucy's Housing Selection is Complete!!

Apartment 1007 is assigned to Lucy and Sally.

After Sally picked the rooms, Lucy logged in, selected her move in date, and signed her License Agreement.

Frequently Asked Questions

I missed the original tours. Will WCM Housing offer another tour?

Yes, one more tour will be offered the week of July 7. Stay tuned for details.

I created a roommate group and now want to change it. What do I do?

You can change your preferred roommate anytime during the profile creation period. After the profile creation period ends you cannot change your roommate.

I entered housing selection with a roommate and we don't like any of the options. What can we do?

You can break up a housing group during the selection period, prior to selecting a room. After breaking up a housing group, each person can pick a room individually or opt out of the process.

Can I see what apartments are available before my room selections timeslot? Unfortunately, no. We hope to have this feature in future versions.



Frequently Asked Questions

Will there be a waitlist for the new residence hall?

Yes, there will be a waitlist.

After the new dorm housing reassignment is complete, will WCM conduct another housing process to backfill the empty rooms?

Once the new dormitory is occupied, WCM Housing will evaluate the current housing occupancy rates. WCM Housing will permit moves within the other buildings. It is yet to be determined how formalized the process will be (i.e. another reapplication process using the WCM Housing Portal).



Frequently Asked Questions

Is there carpeting in the new residence hall?

There is carpeting in the common areas such as hallways and study areas. There is no carpeting inside any of the residences.

Are pets allowed in the new residence hall?

Unfortunately, no pets are allowed in any WCM Housing. If you require a support animal, please contact the Office of Institutional Equity.

How do I reserve space in the yoga room/gym/music room?

Housing Operations will oversee room reservations, and they can be made via the WCM Housing Portal
